Lynn Bauer Champion for Kids Award

Lynn Bauer, a native New Yorker and an entrepreneur from early childhood, has a lifetime of serving others, with a special focus on children. A registered Nurse with open heart ICU experience, she attended medical school in Santo Domingo. During that time, she took weekend jaunts to Cap Haitien, Haiti, where she would tend to lepers, young and old who were ostracized by society.

Years later in 2005, Lynn was one of Executive Directors and Co-Founders of Sunil's Home, an orphanage in Samisragudem, India. There, she and fellow philanthropists bought property and built a 6500 square foot home for 64 orphans who lovingly refer to her as Mom Lynn. She and fiance, Dr. Hal Wanless, made numerous trips to India to make sure all went well and after 10 years the orphanage is self-sufficient. While helping Sunil's Home, Lynn and Hal also shared their time, talent and treasure for the last 20 years, with The Dr. Marvin Dunn academy for Community Education (ACE), an Alternative High School. Lynn enlisted help from Kiwanis and others to host events, donate supplies and more.

For 30 years using her Coral Gables, Fl. home base at Bauer Financial she has served in countless other ways becoming a Community Advocate and Benefactor to many causes that are close to her heart especially when children are in need. Lynn as she tries to always keep one eye cocked toward helping kids which was easily accomplished in 2017 to 2019 as Chairman of the Board of the Coral Gables. Museum and she has since continued to be Board Chair of the Education Dept. working with a talented staff of professionals to have a dynamic and educational Dept.


